How do students move from level to level, class to class?

Students progress by achieving the outcomes in their classes, all of which include both a combination of independent out-of-class and in-class assessments. A "C," which indicates satisfactory achievement of outcomes, is necessary to move to the next level in any of the reading, writing, or oral/receptive communication strands. We also post-test students in the Accuplacer as well as with departmental essays, not for promotion purposes, but rather to show how students have improved as a whole. It is a "test" for our department – are we doing our job?"
